Plagiarism

- Assignments checked on plagiarism
 - Tool to support <u>decision by examiner</u> (Simcheck/Turnitin)
 - No strict maximum percentage
- Academic Skills
 - Extensive grading schema (next slide)
 - gradual increase on strictness in programme



Plagiarism deductions This criteria shows problems with the proper use of referencing that leads to plagiarism issues. The deductions determined in this criteria will be subtracted by the coordinator from the grade that comes out of the other criteria of the rubric, e.g. 8.0 - 20% =>6.4

0 Pts % Full score No problems detected All citations, guotes and referencing done according to the "rules," e.g., all intellectual property of other people is referenced to the source: lauotes used are appropriate (needed for the argumentation), are correctly marked with quotation marks and with a source. Shows the citation which includes the student's effort to try to page number; text has been paraphrased into the Ifrom several sources and words of the student.

0 Pts 10% deduction Appropriate quotation of a A large number of sentence or major part of a overlapping words, but but no quotation marks and/or no page number with the reference. G-AI - ChatGPT

UT policy on Academic Misconduct states: "An exam/test is an investigation of knowledge, skills and insight of a student. A student has to deliver only his own original work. If not, it will be considered as fraud or plagiarism. Also, free-riding behaviour, benefiting from other people's efforts in groups (assignments) while not putting in the same effort as the other group members, can be considered fraud."



G-AI - ChatGPT

- Any task (assignment, written test, presentation, report) will explicitly describe whether and which Al tools are allowed.
- In case AI tools are used you need to properly reference (APA7th for AI_ChatBots).

Scripting/programming can benefit from GAI

- Redefinition of Learning Outcomes
- Gradual inclusion of Al-based coding tools as an extra utility to learn
- Subtle redefinition of group assignments/testing to allow for use of AI, yet continue testing the student skills, not the AI skills



Standards

- At course level: Evasys outcome < 3 needs reflection
- At programme accreditation level: Meet all 4 standards (ILO, T&L, Assessment, Obtained LO)
