

# NSE results M-GEO 2023

## Main results

- **Response:** 62 out of 191 (33%), in 2022 this was 39% and in 2021 49%.
- Score on **3 most important indicators:**
  - General satisfaction lower than 2022
  - Atmosphere higher than 2022
  - Choosing programme again lower than 2022
- General satisfaction (3,82) puts M-GEO **in the bottom half of UT Master's programmes**
- Almost no significant changes compared to last year

# Theme & item scores that stand out

## Theme scores (based on scores of underlying items)

- 4 themes have a higher score than 2022
- 6 show a slight decrease
- Highest difference with UT: International aspects (+0,41)

## Item scores

- Average score of all items decreases from 3,97 to 3,93
- Largest differences compared to 2022:
  - The teachers provide good support (+0,17)
  - How the examination and assessment matches the content of the programme (+0,23, against -0,16 in 2022)
  - I am regularly engaged in learning and work with the subject material (-0,26)
  - Learning critical thinking (-0,26)

## Highest theme scores

- teachers (4,09)
- Guidance/counselling (4,02)
- Scientific skills (4,00)

## Lowest theme scores

- study load (3,52)
- connection to professional practice/career (3,84)
- examination and assessment (3,86)
